

# UNICEF 2023 WASH Annual Global Partners Feedback Meeting (Closed Session) - Concept Note

13 June 2023 (0800-1030 New York)

The UNICEF 2023 WASH Annual Global Partners Feedback Meeting (**Closed Session**) will be held virtually (via Microsoft Teams – link is on the shared calendar invite) and in person at UNICEF House, New York, on **June 13, 2023**. The main purpose of this meeting is for a select core group of global partners to have a formal opportunity to provide feedback to UNICEF on the programme results, as presented in the 2022 Goal 4 Global Annual Results Report and to offer further reflections on the strategic direction and planned results for the UNICEF Strategic Plan 2022-2025 period. For the *Tour de Table* discussion we kindly request partners to consider, in addition to their overall feedback, to share reflections and insights on the following guiding questions:

1. *What is changing in the sector post the UN 2023 Water conference and what do we want as a WASH sector?*
2. *What do partners see as UNICEF’s role in this post-UN 2023 Water Conference landscape?*
3. *What are the shifts UNICEF needs to accelerate in the current global context, mindful of interacting fragility, but also increasing need for stronger national WASH systems?*
